

It was two brothers called Orville and Wilbur Wright invented the aeroplane; this was a huge milestone in the world of international travel and transportation. It meant that people could take trips that previously would have taken months by train or boat.

use their wings to fly to help them to build their first aeroplane.

It was Orville Wright who made the first flight in California, America. The flight lasted for **12**

seconds and went to 120 feet.

That's three times as high as 9 double Deckerbuses on top of each other!
