I can <u>make specific links</u> between the words of St Paul and the Christian's call to holiness, and between Hosea 11: 1-4 and God as a loving parent.




- I can give reasons for many actions by believers, such as Maximilian Kolbe, as a consequence of their belief in a call to holiness and using their talents.
