

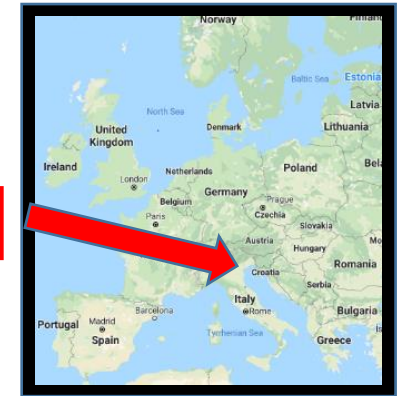
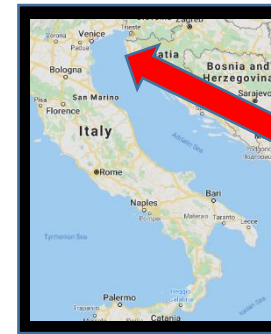


Antonio Lucio Vivaldi

He was born on 4th March 1678 in Venice, Italy.

He died on 28th July 1741

He was a composer of the Baroque period.

Interesting facts about Vivaldi:

Vivaldi was ordained as a priest in 1703.

He was a very good (skilled) violinist.

He made a lot of money in his life but when he died, he was poor.






He wrote orchestral, choral and solo instrumental music.






JS Bach loved his music.

He was known as "the red priest" because of his red hair.
