


What is History?

History is when we learn about the past. We learn about people, artefacts and events that have already happened. We learn about chronology and timelines.

What is Chronology?

Chronology is the process of arranging events in their order of occurrence in time.

| Present | Existing or occurring now. |
| Evidence | Available facts or information to prove that something is true. |
| Document | A piece of written matter. |
