I can explain the characteristics of different animal groups.


I can compare the types of foods that animals eat.

Prior Knowledge

Grouping Animals

We can group animals into five different groups based on their characteristics.

Some animals are carnivores, some are herbivores and some are omnivores.


Animals Knowledge Organiser



Vocabulary

Carnivore	An animal that only eats meat.
Herbivore	An animal that only eats plants.
Omnivore	An animal that eats both plants and meat.
Vertebrate	An animal with a backbone.
Invertebrate	An animal without a backbone.
Reproduce	Living things produce babies/offspring.

All animals including humans change as they develop into an adult. This is called a life cycle.



This is a food chain. This shows what the next source of food is for each living thing. The sparrowhawk consumes the thrush, the thrush consumes the snail and the snail consumes the clover.
