


Animals

An animal that lives in water and on land.



Invertebrate
An animal that doesn't have a backbone.

An animal that lives with people in their houses

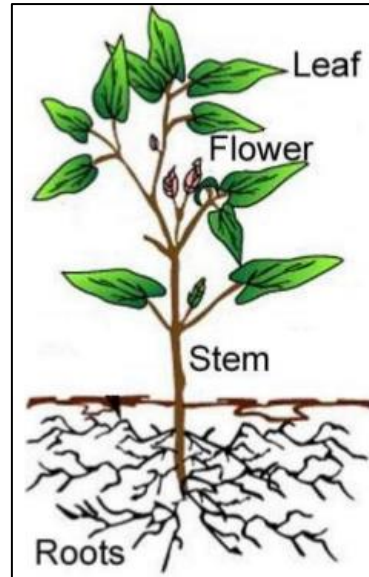
Reptile
An animal that lives on land and has scaly skin.



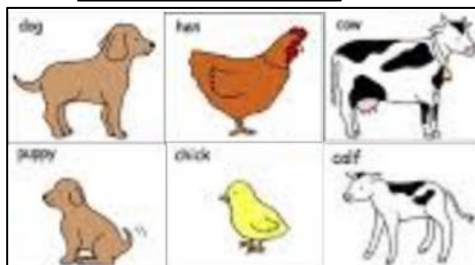
Mammal

Key vocabulary

Common Garden	Flowers that grow somewhere because a person has planted them.
Wild Flowers	Flowers that grow anywhere – a person hasn't planted them.
Evergreen tree	A tree that has green leaves all year round.
Deciduous tree	A tree that has leaves which grow and shed every year, usually in the Autumn.
Categorise	Sorting things into specific groups.
Vertebrate	An animal that does have a backbone.
Invertebrate	An animal that doesn't have a backbone.
Habitat	Where an animal lives that is suited to their needs.
Offspring	A baby; an animal's young.
