### Key Knowledge

- In **Advent** we **wait** and get ready for **Christmas** – Jesus' birthday.
- The Advent **Wreath** is an evergreen circle with 3 purple candles and 1 pink candle. The candles represent the 4 weeks of Advent. Each week another candle is lit.
- The **Angel** Gabriel visited **Mary**.
- Mary** loved God so much that she agreed to be the Mother of Jesus.
- Mary** visited her cousin **Elizabeth**.
- Elizabeth** was waiting to have her baby, John.
- Jesus** was born in a stable in **Bethlehem**.
- A **messenger** from God visited the **shepherds** to tell them that a special baby had been born. They hurried to see **Mary, Joseph** and the baby **Jesus**.
- The Christingle helps us understand love and why he sent Jesus to be the light of the world.



### Key Vocabulary and Definitions

<b>Advent</b>	The time of waiting and preparing for Christmas.
<b>Bethlehem</b>	The town where Jesus was born.
<b>celebrate</b>	To make special with gifts, parties or events.
<b>Christmas</b>	The time when we remember the birthday of Jesus.
<b>manger</b>	An animal's eating trough.
<b>messenger</b>	An angel sent by God to deliver a message.
<b>preparing</b>	To get ready.
<b>waiting</b>	To look forward to something and be ready for it.
<b>worship</b>	Showing love and devotion.
