### Key Knowledge

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent.

Lent is a time where we give things up, like how Jesus gave up things in the desert and then his life for us.

Holy Week is the final 7 days leading up to Easter. It begins on Palm Sunday.

Palm Sunday is when Jesus rode through Jerusalem on a donkey.

Maundy Thursday is when Jesus had the last supper with the disciples and washed their feet.

Good Friday is when Jesus was crucified. The stations of the cross tell us this story.

On Easter Sunday Jesus rose again.



### Key Vocabulary and Definitions

<b>Crucified</b>	Nailed to a cross
<b>Temptation</b>	The desire to do something, often something wrong or bad.
<b>Fast</b>	Refrain from eating a certain food or drink
<b>Disciples</b>	Followers of Jesus
<b>Tomb</b>	A large enclosure, usually in a rock.



The order of Holy week: Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday
