Please focus not only on the words in the book but also on your child's understanding of what they have read. Also, please ensure that when a child reads, that their diary is signed by an adult.

Please continue to encourage your child to work independently on their homework and to use a pencil. Finally, please continue to use Numbots and you can now also start using TT Rockstars! For those of you on RWI Comprehension, you should be using Accelerated Reader.

Please ensure your child has their PE kit with them on the first day back after the break. We ask that you make sure a P.E. kit is in school every day and that all your child's uniform is clearly labelled.
